FOR TAILGATES WITH INTERIOR ACCESS PANELS

Tools Required:

- 3/16" Hex Socket or Allen
- Drill
- 9/32" or 5/16" Drill Bit
- Extra set of hands.

What's in the box?

- (1) R1 Wing
- (4) Stainless Steel Bolts & washers
- 1. Insure that the tailgate is clean from any dirt. Use water with soap to clean if necessary. Do not use other cleaning products as it may not allow the tape to stick.
- 2. Mask the area with tape where the mounts will land. This will protect the tailgate and allow you to clearly see where you marked the holes. Hold the wing up towards the top of the tailgate and center it from left to right and ensure the mounts are flush up against the tailgate.
- 3. Once you found the perfect spot, go ahead and mark the holes and drill. Please use a pilot hole! Do not risk using the drill bit from the start as it may walk on you causing the holes not to line up with the spoiler.
- 4. Remove the tailgate's access panel from the inside.
- 5. Have a friend put the wing on with the screws while you reach inside and put a nut on the screw. Tighten them all up and put the access panel back on.

FOR TAILGATES WITH OUT INTERIOR ACCESS PANEL

Tools Required:

- 3/16" Hex Socket or Allen
- Drill
- 25/32" Drill Bit
- Extra set of hands.

What's in the box?

- (1) R1 Wing
- (4) Stainless Steel Bolts & washers
- Rivet Nut & Quick Tool
- 7. Insure that the tailgate is clean from any dirt. Use water with soap to clean if necessary. Do not use other cleaning products as it may not allow the tape to stick.
- 8. Mask the area with tape where the mounts will land. This will protect the tailgate and allow you to clearly see where you marked the holes. Hold the wing up towards the top of the tailgate and center it from left to right and ensure the mounts are flush up against the tailgate.
- 9. Once you found the perfect spot, go ahead and mark the holes and drill. Please use a pilot hole! Do not risk using the drill bit from the start as it may walk on you causing the holes not to line up with the spoiler.
